TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

I. ELIGIBILITY

A. Eligible to participate are players from universities, colleges, and Schools.

Registration Fee is five hundred pesos only (Php500.00) for college and high school
And three hundred pesos only (Php300.00) for elementary students

- **Deadline for online registration will be on July 18, 2019 at 12:00 noon only**
- **Please bring your proof of enrollment (COR, CE & Valid School ID)**

II. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

A. Swiss System (7 Rounds)

III. COMPETITION RULES

- A. The tournament shall be governed by the FIDE Laws of Chess.
- B. Time control shall be FIFTEEN (15) MINUTES with 10 seconds increment for each player to make all the moves necessary to finish the game using the digital clocks.
- C. Penalty for illegal moves claimed by the opponent:
 - 1. 1st Offense – additional two (2) minutes thinking time for the claimant.
 - 2. 2nd Offense – loss of the game
- D. The use of cellphones and other electronic means of communication while the game is in progress is prohibited. A player who will violate this provision shall lose his/her game by forfeiture.
- E. Pairings shall be generated by the Swiss Manager pairing program. NO PROTEST ON PAIRING shall be entertained.

V. TIE BREAKS

The following tie-break systems, in descending order of priority, shall be applied to determine the final ranking of players in each category.

- 1. Direct encounter
- 2. Buchholz System
- 3. Median Buchholz System (minus score of the highest and lowest opponents)
- 4. S.B System
- 5. More number of wins (including un-played games)

- VI. The organizers reserve the right to amend or alter any provision of the afore-mentioned rules and regulations for the success and interest of the tournament.
